

Crochet Pattern CP2: Baby Boy/Girl Jacket (12 Mth) in UK Terminology

This pattern is designed for babies 12 months of age and utilizes UK crochet terminology. Materials

- Yarn: Medium weight yarn, approximately 300-350 yards
- Crochet hook: Size 4mm (US G/6)
- Buttons: 3-4 buttons, 12-15mm in diameter
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Abbreviations (UK Terminology)

- ch: chain
- dc: double crochet
- tr: treble crochet
- sl st: slip stitch
- sc: single crochet
- hdc: half double crochet

Pattern

Body

1. Ch 60. Dc into the 4th ch from the hook and each ch across. (57 dc)
2. Ch 3, turn. Dc into each dc across. (57 dc)
3. Repeat Row 2 for 10 more rows.
4. Divide the work in half, marking the center with a stitch marker. (28 dc on each side)
5. Continue working on the right side only. Ch 3, turn. Dc into each dc across. (28 dc)
6. Repeat Row 5 for 10 more rows.
7. Fasten off and leave a long tail for seaming.

Left Side

1. Attach the yarn to the center stitch of the marked half. Ch 3, turn. Dc into each dc across. (28 dc)
2. Repeat Row 1 for 10 more rows.
3. Fasten off and leave a long tail for seaming.

Sleeves

1. Ch 30. Dc into the 4th ch from the hook and each ch across. (27 dc)
2. Ch 3, turn. Dc into the 2nd dc from the hook, *dc into each dc across, dc into the turning ch*. (28 dc)
3. Repeat Row 2 for 11 more rows.
4. Fasten off and leave a long tail for seaming.

Assembly

1. Seam the shoulders by placing the right side of the right side body panel next to the wrong side of the left side body panel. Join the edges with a whip stitch.
2. Seam the side seams in the same manner.
3. Insert the sleeves into the armholes, matching the center of the sleeves to the shoulder seams. Seam the sleeves in place.
4. Fold up the bottom edge of the jacket by about 2 inches and seam it in place to create a hem.
5. Sew the buttons onto the front of the jacket, spacing them evenly.

Finishing Touches

Your adorable baby jacket is now complete! Give it a gentle wash and lay it flat to dry to maintain its shape. This cozy and charming jacket will keep your little one warm and stylish during their first year.

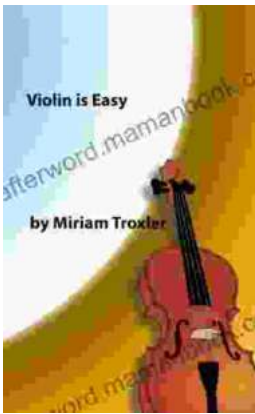

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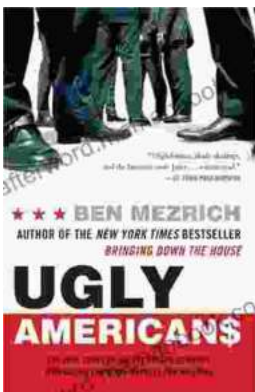


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
