Worsted weight yarn in white, red, and black

- Crochet hook size H (5.00 mm)
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

Instructions:

Santa Towel Topper:

- 1. **Round 1:** With white yarn, make a magic ring and ch 2. Work 10 sc in the ring. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (10 sc)
- 2. **Round 2:** Ch 2. Work 2 sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (20 sc)
- 3. **Round 3:** Ch 2. Work *1 sc in the next sc, 2 sc in the next sc*. Repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (30 sc)
- 4. **Round 4:** Ch 2. Work *2 sc in the next sc, 1 sc in the next 2 sc*. Repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (40 sc)
- 5. **Round 5:** Ch 2. Work 1 sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (40 sc)
- 6. **Round 6:** Ch 2. Work *1 sc in the next 2 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*. Repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (50 sc)
- 7. **Round 7:** Ch 2. Work 1 sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (50 sc)
- 8. **Round 8:** Ch 2. Work *2 sc in the next sc, 1 sc in the next 3 sc*. Repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (60 sc)
- 9. **Round 9:** Ch 2. Work 1 sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (60 sc)

- 10. **Round 10:** Ch 2. Work *1 sc in the next 3 sc, 2 sc in the next sc*. Repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (70 sc)
- 11. **Hat Brim:** Ch 2. Work 1 sc in each sc around, working only in the back loop of each stitch. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (70 sc)



12. **Beard:** Leaving a long tail for sewing, cut a piece of white yarn. Attach the yarn to the base of the hat brim and ch 10. Sc in the next 2 sc, dc

- in the next 2 sc, tr in the next 2 sc, dc in the next 2 sc, sc in the next 2 sc. SI st to the first ch. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.
- 13. **Nose:** Make a magic ring with red yarn. Ch 2. Work 6 sc in the ring. Join with a sl st to the first sc. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.
- 14. **Eyes:** With black yarn, make a magic ring and ch 2. Work 6 sc in the ring. Join with a sl st to the first sc. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends. Repeat for the other eye.
- 15. **Attach Beard, Nose, and Eyes:** Sew the beard to the bottom of the hat brim. Glue or sew the nose and eyes to the face.

Snowman Towel Topper:

- 1. **Round 1:** With white yarn, make a magic ring and ch 2. Work 10 sc in the ring. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (10 sc)
- 2. **Round 2:** Ch 2. Work 2 sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (20 sc)
- 3. **Round 3:** Ch 2. Work *1 sc in the next sc, 2 sc in the next sc*. Repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (30 sc)
- 4. **Round 4:** Ch 2. Work 1 sc in each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (30 sc)
- 5. **Head:** Repeat Rounds 2-4 to create a second ball. Join the two balls with a sl st through the last stitch of each round.
- 6. **Body:** Ch 2. Work 1 sc in each sc around the bottom ball. Do not join. Continue working 1 sc in each sc for 10 rounds or until the body reaches your desired length. Join with a sl st to the first sc.

- 7. **Hat:** Ch 2. Work *2 sc in the next sc, 1 sc in the next 2 sc*. Repeat from * around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (40 sc)
- 8. **Hat Brim:** Ch 2. Work 1 sc in each sc around, working only in the back loop of each stitch. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (40 sc)
- 9. **Scarf:** With any color yarn, ch 100. Sc in the second ch from the hook and each ch across. Join with a sl st to the first sc. Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.
- 10. **Attach Hat, Brim, and Scarf:** Sew the hat to the top of the snowman's head. Glue or sew the hat brim to the bottom of the hat. Wrap the scarf around the snowman's neck and tie the ends together.
- 11. **Buttons:** With black yarn, make 3 small circles by working 6 sc in a magic ring and joining with a sl st. Sew the buttons to the snowman's body.

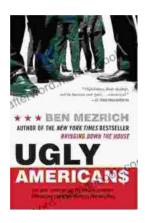
